



MEMBER APPRECIATION RECEPTION



GRANTS IN MUSIC



Grant funding from SSMA is provided to Central New York non-profit organizations (Cayuga, Cortland, Madison, Oneida, Onondaga or Oswego counties) that offer music programming, music education, or community support through music and have operated for a minimum of 2 years.

The SSMA Grants in Music Program criteria:

- 1. Support and encourage student musicians.
- 2. Implement outreach.
- 3. Serve a diverse group of people.
- 4. Benefit the CNY community.

Grants are to be used for music events or projects. Dollar amounts range from \$500 - \$5,000 and must not be used to cover operating expenses or scholarships. Requests may include:

- 1. Financial support for a concert or performance (hiring guest artists and/or purchase of music)
- 2. Continuing education projects
- 3. Student tuition
- 4. Purchase of instruments or other music equipment
- 5. Repair of instruments

2023 was a stellar year for our Grants in Music Program. 23 musically related non-profit organizations were awarded grants totaling \$56,200, including 6 new organizations!


2023 INTERMEZZO LUNCHEON

In 2023, SSMA awarded Symphor!a \$25,000, the highest dollar amount to date, to underwrite the Holiday Pops concert performances on December 16, 2023, to sponsor the Kids Concert Series, and to sponsor the Coronation Celebration in the Casual Series in March 2024.

ENCORE THRIFT SHOP



As we enter our 16th year of operation, Encore Thrift Shop is flourishing beyond all our hopes and aspirations. As in the past, we continue to be the largest source of funding for SSMA grants. Each year we have been able to increase our funding due to an increase in profits.

Our wonderful volunteer staff has seen an increase in new recruits, and we continually welcome additional volunteers. Thanks to their generosity we have increased our Saturday hours. Encore shop located at

119 Brooklea Drive, Fayetteville, NY is now open Tuesday through Friday from 11 am to 4 pm and Saturdays from 11 am to 3 pm. (315-637-6133).

We continue to receive wonderful donations of lightly used women's clothing and shoes, jewelry, art work and housewares; some items have come from as far away as Maine and Long Island. A majority of the items are sold in the shop, but many high-end items are sold on eBay as well as Facebook Marketplace. We always welcome your donations; no appointment is needed.

Encore is run entirely by SSMA Board Members, with many duties parceled out to our dedicated volunteers. We always welcome new volunteers for shifts of two and half hours. Volunteers can sign up for a permanent workday or fill in where needed.

HISTORY

In 1960, the Syracuse Symphony Orchestra was established, and the Syracuse Symphony Association (the Guild's successor) was founded to help support it financially through various means of fundraising.

In the Spring of 2011, the SSO began the transition to a new business model, and officially became Symphor!a in December of 2012. The SSA reorganized, as well, becoming the **Syracuse Sounds of Music Association**, **Inc.** (SSMA) in the Fall of 2011.

Since then, the SSMA has successfully raised funds to support not only Symphor!a, but many CNY non-profit organizations that present music programming or offer music education.
